☐ Shaving cream

□ Food coloring

☐ Shallow pan

☐ Plain non-glossy white paper


☐ Ruler or spatula


Paper marbling sprawls continents and centuries. Take one look at its stone-like or curlicue effects and it's easy to see why. A variety of methods produce marbled paper. In this example, we will explore the method using shaving cream. Then use your marbled paper for cards, gift wrap, or place it in a frame for one-of-a-kind art!



## WHAT YOU DO:

- Dispense a mound of shaving cream in a shallow pan or countertop.
- Level it out with a ruler or spatula as best you can.





- Lift the paper off. Gently rinse under running water and let dry.
- f. If the paper is more wrinkled than you'd like, have an adult help you iron it between two plain sheets of paper on the low setting.
